Interactive Television Classes Laptop Computer Student Policy

Interactive Television Technology provides students with educational opportunities that are special both in content and in the way that they are made available. Participation should be considered an exciting opportunity as well as a privilege that carries with it a high level of responsibility.

Because of the manner in which ITV classes are delivered, certain standards of student behavior are expected of all students enrolling in these courses. This policy is intended to make participating students and their parents or guardians aware of the standards expected. Students issued laptop computers agree to the following standards.

- 1) Students are responsible for the safe keeping and security of the computers that are issued to them. When the laptop is not with the student on school premises, it is to be kept at the administrative office, not in a student locker.
- 2) Laptop computers are sensitive to adverse weather conditions. Never leave them in a car where they can freeze or be exposed to extreme heat. If the computer is cold, let it warm up before you plug it in or turn it on.
- 3) Laptop computers are the personal responsibility of the student they are provided to and are for school use. This means they are not to be borrowed out, loaned to friends, or used for other non-approved purposes.
- 4) Students are expected to follow the acceptable use policies for technology for their home school. Failure to do so or other use of the laptop computer for inappropriate activities may result in the immediate forfeiture of use of a laptop computer. This includes access of Internet sites of a sexual, vulgar, hate related, or other areas that are in direct conflict with school policy.

First Offense:

The student will be given a verbal warning by the classroom instructor and their parent/guardian(s) will be notified as to the infraction. The notification will be in writing to the parent/guardian, coordinator, and home school.

Second Offense: The student will lose the use of a laptop computer.

SEVERE MISCONDUCT: The student will immediately lose their computer
