The Environmental and Natural Resource team placed 10th in the nation. Kalie Boehm received a silver award while Kiersten Boehm, Eric Moen, and Nick Wulfekuhle each earned a gold rating. The event consisted of wildlife identification, soils, water analysis, GPS, and a waste management team problem and presentation.

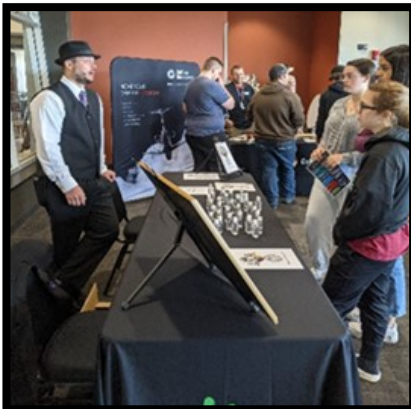




Oakes Seniors Attend Manufacturing Day at Jamestown at the Newman Arena, Oct 6th.

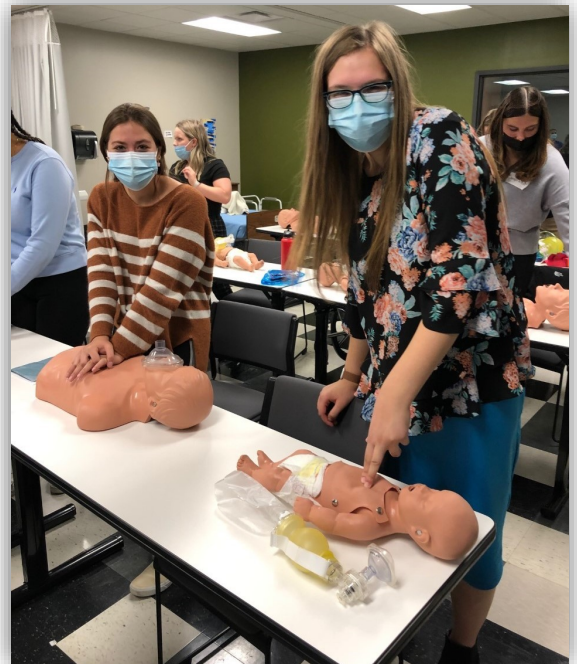
HOSA FALL LEADERSHIP OUTLOOK

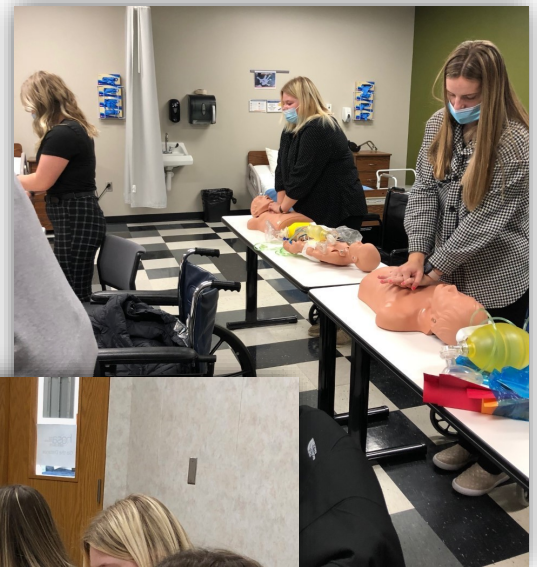
